PASCO COUNTY LAWN AND LANDSCAPE WATERING RESTRICTIONS

Phase III

(Effective: 12:01 am April 3, 2009)

All Water Users : Utility Customers and Citizens with **Private Wells**, Pasco County Remains on a One-Day/Week Lawn-Watering Schedule.

Your lawn and landscape Watering day is based upon the **LAST NUMBER** of your address.

0-1 Monday
2-3 Tuesday
4-5 Wednesday
6-7 Thursday
8-9 Friday

Mixed **OR** No Address - Friday

Non-Watering Days - Saturday and Sunday

*(For example, if your address is 4205 Pyrite Drive, your watering schedule is Wednesday, 12:01 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. **OR** 6:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.)*

***You may only water from 12:01 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. OR 6:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m., on your designated day.**

Car and Pressure Washing:

Residential car washing is allowed once per week, **ONLY** if you use well water. Car-washing shall be accomplished using low volume methods only, such as with a hand-held hose equipped with a trigger nozzle and shall be restricted to only one washing a week. **At a residential property, this activity may occur on Tuesday or Saturday for Even Address, or Wednesday or Sunday for Odd Address.**

Pressure washing conducted by commercial businesses and those residents on well water are allowed for certain purposes, which include cleaning to eliminate a safety hazard, **preparation for painting**, or similar activity, maintaining a paint or material warranty, and as needed to meet Federal, State or local health and Safety standards.

Violators will be subject to enforcement and fines.

In response to this latest water shortage declaration by the Southwest Florida Water Management District, Pasco County and all other Counties and cities within the Tampa Bay Area must step up enforcement. **Pasco County Code Enforcement officers and Utility personnel will increase their joint efforts to enforce water restrictions. No warning will be issued. First violation is \$130 plus court fees. Second violation is \$260 plus court fees. Third and subsequent violations are \$500 plus court fees and a mandatory court appearance. (Modified 3/25/2009)**
